- Artwork can be in any medium pencil-crayons, markers, water colours, airbrush etc. NEW for 2018 artwork can also be created with found items like shells, beach glass, twigs, rope, bottle tops, discarded materials. Glitter is plastic so please DO NOT USE.
- The name, age, school and contact information should be clearly printed at the back of the artwork. Your name or signature should not be written on the front of the painting.
- Keep artwork flat do not roll.

DEADLINE

All entries must be submitted by 4pm on Thursday March 22, 2018. All artwork must be delivered to one of our convenient drop off locations, **Harper Office Depot** or **AHTA Office** in St Johns and **Antigua Sailing Week Office** in English Harbour.

Judging will occur by a panel of artists & community organizers. Judges decision will be final.
