



The Royal Southern Yacht Club Inter-Yacht Club Challenge

The Rules

1. The competition will be known as the Royal Southern Yacht Club Inter-Yacht Club Challenge ('the Challenge').
2. The Shield Trophy to be awarded to the winner of the Challenge will remain the property of the Royal Southern Yacht Club ('RSrNYC') and will remain in RSrNYC's possession or in the possession of the organisers of Antigua Sailing Week.
3. 2015 was the inaugural year for the Challenge and the 2015 rules will remain in effect for 2018. They are designed to accommodate competitors racing in different classes. Rules for the Challenge may be modified for future years.
4. Competitors will race in the class they are allocated to by the organisers of Antigua Sailing Week.
5. The finishing positions will be decided based on a weighted scoring system with the lowest number of points winning.
6. The scoring system to be used to decide the winners of the Challenge will be the well-established results program formula used by the organisers of Antigua Sailing Week.
7. The crew of each competing yacht must have at least 50% of its crew members from the Yacht Club it represents in the Challenge. However, a concession may be granted upon application at the sole discretion of the Organising Committee.
8. The Antigua Sailing Week Organising Committee's decision on all matters is final.
9. Club Class entrants are not eligible to enter the Royal Southern Yacht Club Inter-Yacht Club Challenge.
